






#### **Emergence**



# A year of engaging problems with emerging solutions

hat a year for investing in healthcare! If you recall, in April and May of 2021, news agencies ran numerous stories of the horrific onslaught of Covid-19 in India with heart-breaking images of overtaxed crematoriums, and patients dying in the streets unable to gain access to hospital care. It was truly a devastating crisis. Hospitals were completely unprepared to handle that surge. All of our partner hospitals were converted into Covid-19 units, but like hospitals around the world, they had huge shortages of space, PPE, medicines, and most critically, a short supply of oxygen.

While our partners in India were reeling from the onslaught of a Covid-19 wave like none other, your support provided funds for:

- oxygen-generating equipment critical for treatment of Covid-19 patients
- additional hospital equipment like ventilators and para-monitors
- medicine and PPE
- restructuring space that put Covid-19 patients and healthcare workers on better footing.
- increased investment in community health
- an online platform for counseling and mental health
- veterinary anti-parasitic medication for over 1,000 animals enabling them to better reproduce and to generate more milk, thus empowering the families that own the animals.
- food distribution: Protection from disease is not helpful if you are not able to survive. You also provided funds for emergency food and supplies

Surrounded by death, our partners reached out to give more dignity to those at the end stage of life. They've increased their palliative care efforts, making a new center in the hospital, to augment their continuing home palliative care.

ducational opportunities in rural North India are meager. In addition, there is a tremendous shortage of medical professionals and nurses. Providing nursing education is so transformative and cost effective, we believe that we cannot afford not to make this investment.

This year your partnership is enabling 30 young women and men to attend nursing school, the most ever supported by HIT. You also provided smart phones for remote learning so education could continue when in-person education was impossible.

Investing in primary, secondary, and vocational education is just as important. In a second program, your partnership supports vocational training of young women and men. This advanced education requires a pipeline of qualified young women and men. To help with this pipeline, we also invest in primary education through our partners who:

- operate more than 85 study centers serving over 3,000 children.
- run a high school study center that prepares 30 students each year for more advanced education
- support an orphanage that cares for and educates approximately 20 young boys and girls.

And new this year: You enabled investment in a center for education and therapy for those with physical and mental disabilities – a rare facility in rural north India.

The pandemic crushed village life with loss of heads of families, income providers, and caretakers. With your partnership, we:

- invested in programs that taught rural village leaders to identify problems and develop solutions
- taught women how to access government programs, submit the proper forms, and obtain assistance for their villages as well as their families
- increased our investment in counseling training for leaders, enabling them to help devastated families and individuals.

Previously our partners needed to travel throughout India to deliver individual and group leadership training. Now, using remote mechanisms, they are able to reach five times as many people across the subcontinent.

Not all leadership training material was available in India. Therefore, we also provided funds for leaders to take US-based courses online.
